ARROW at the Europeana Project Cluster Group Meeting on IPR

Brussels, 28 May 2009. On May 27th, Europeana organised a Cluster meeting with other relevant European Commission sponsored projects at the National Library in Prague. The attendees, representing seven related projects - Europeana v. 1.0, Europeana Connect, Arrow, Athena, BHL Europe, EFG, APEnet, PrestoPrime and EUScreen - shared information on their work and experiences, in particular with respect to Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

A main objective of the meeting was to identify any overlaps that there might be between the projects with the view to enhancing the cooperation between them in relation to Europeana. It gave the different project representatives the opportunity to understand better the work carried out by other initiatives.
